- 1. What is the cost of living in this community?
 - a. What is the rate for your desired room type?
 - b. What services are included in the base room rate?
 - c. Are there additional fees for the below needs:
 - · Medication Assistance
 - · Assistance with ADLS
 - · Transportation Services
 - · Meal Services
 - · Laundry Services
 - d. Can a resident's rate go up? If so, what can they expect?
- 2. How will my loved-one's medications and appointments with medical providers be handled once he/she is moved in?
 - · Are there on-site providers that come to the community?
 - · What if the resident wants to keep their own doctor and/or pharmacy?
 - · If receiving home health or hospice services can the same agency see a resident after move-in?
- 3. Do you have a resident handbook or resource for residents with the community's house rules and policies?
- 4. Is there a menu posted or does the community have a sample menu available for residents to look at? What happens if a resident doesn't

like the meal on a particular day or has special dietary preferences?

- 5. Is there a sample schedule of activities? What kinds of activities are provided?
- 6. Does the community offer internet? What about cable or satellite? If so, what are the fees?
- 7. Does the room come furnished? What is allowed from home?
- 8. What are the community's visitation and leave policy?
- Can a resident keep and maintain their automobile while living at the community?
- 10. If the resident needs to go to the hospital what happens?
 - · Can they go to the hospital of their choice?
 - · Will their room be reserved?
 - · What if they need a higher level of care?
 - · Who will be notified?
